*... And behold, no one had come to the camp from Jabesh-gilead to the assembly. <sup>9</sup>For when the people were numbered, behold, not one of the inhabitants of Jabesh-gilead was there. Judges 21:8 -9*

*Jabesh- Yabesh to be dry, dried up, withered*

*Gilead- Galad from Gala- to expose, lay bare*
