Peddle: kapeelos - to be a retailer, to peddle (Thayer's)

The word "appears" means "be revealed" (Wiersbe p.73)

**Paul explained that this exam is for \_\_\_\_\_ 1 Cor. 13-15**  
...each man's work will become evident; for the day will show it  
because it is to be revealed (**phaneros**) with fire, and the fire itself  
will test the quality of each man's work. 14 If any man's work which  
he has built on it remains, he will receive a reward. 15 If any man's  
work is burned up, he will suffer loss; but he himself will be saved,  
yet so as through fire. 1 Corinthians 3:13-15

**Note: The \_\_\_\_\_ are burned up,  
not the \_\_\_\_\_**

(v.15) Burned up: katakaio - to burn down (to the ground), i.e.  
consume wholly

**Doesn't say "he suffers" but "he will suffer \_\_\_\_\_" (v.15)**

**Criterion for Rewards: What I did to \_\_\_\_\_ (v.9)**  
But store up for yourselves treasures in heaven, where neither moth  
nor rust destroys, and where thieves do not break in or steal; 21 for  
where your treasure is, there your heart will be also.  
Matthew 6:20-21
