1. I Samuel 31 tells us _____

*Then Saul said to his armor bearer, "Draw your sword and pierce me through with it, otherwise these uncircumcised will come and pierce me through and make sport of me." But his armor bearer would not, for he was greatly afraid. So Saul took his sword and fell on it. ⁵When his armor bearer saw that Saul was dead, he also fell on his sword and died with him. ⁶Thus **Saul died with his three sons**, his armor bearer, and all his men on that day together. 1 Samuel 31:4-6*

So Saul died for his trespass which he committed against the LORD, because of the word of the LORD which he did not keep; and also because he asked counsel of a medium, making inquiry of it, ¹⁴and did not inquire of the LORD. Therefore He killed him and turned the kingdom to David the son of Jesse. 1 Chron. 10:13-14

*"You must never forget what the people of Amalek did to you as you came from Egypt. ¹⁸Remember that they fought with you and struck down those who were **faint** and **weary** and **lagging behind**, with no respect or fear of God. ¹⁹Therefore, when the Lord your God has given you rest from all your enemies in the Promised Land, you are utterly to destroy the name of Amalek from under heaven. Never forget this. Deuteronomy 25:17-19 (TLB)*
