Acts 4:31

Surely our griefs (choliy) He Himself bore, And our sorrows He carried; Yet we ourselves esteemed Him stricken, Smitten of God, and afflicted. But He was pierced through for our transgressions, He was crushed for our iniquities; The chastening for our well-being fell upon Him, And by His scourging we are healed (Rapha) - Isaiah 53:4-5

Griefs: choliy - malady, anxiety, calamity (KJV)
disease, grief, sickness (Strong's) choliy: sickness (BD&B)

*Surely our **sicknesses** he hath borne, And our pains — he hath carried them, - Isaiah 53:4 (YLT)*

Healed: raphe - to mend (by stitching), i.e. (figuratively) to cure
KJV - cure, (cause to) heal, physician, repair, make whole.

Name: onoma - a "name" [authority] (Strong's)

(v.8)

(vv.8-10)
(Peter) if we are on trial today for a benefit done to a sick man, as to how this man has been made well (Sozo) - Acts 4:9

Sozo: to save, i.e. deliver or protect (literally or figuratively) (KJV)
heal, preserve, save (self), do well, be (make) whole (Strong's)
