One who speaks in a tongue edifies (oikodomeo) himself

- 1 Corinthians 14:4

But you, beloved, ought to remember the words that were spoken beforehand by the apostles of our Lord Jesus Christ, that they were saying to you, "In the last time there shall be mockers, following after their own ungodly lusts." These are the ones who cause divisions, worldly-minded, devoid of the Spirit. But you, beloved, building (epoikodomeo) yourselves up on your most holy faith; praying in the Holy Spirit; - Jude 17-20

Oikodomeo: to build (up from the foundation) to restore by building, to rebuild, repair (Thayer's)
