*Ephesus is the guardian of the temple of the great Artemis*  
- Acts 19:35

**The Gospel is Good News and full of \_\_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_\_\_**  
*...to testify solemnly of the gospel (euaggelion) of the grace (charis) of God.* - Acts 20:24

Gospel: euaggelion - Good News; a good message, i.e. the gospel (Strong's)  
Grace: charis - KJV  
joy, liberality, pleasure (Strong's)

*And now I commend you to God and to the word of His grace(charis), which is able to build you up and to give you the inheritance among all those who are sanctified.* (v.32)

(vv.33-35)  
*Don't you know that those who work in the temple get their food from the temple, and those who serve at the altar share in what is offered on the altar? In the same way, the Lord has commanded that those who preach the gospel should receive their living from the gospel.*  
- 1 Corinthians 9:13-14

*You yourselves know that these hands of mine have supplied my own needs and the needs of my companions* - Acts 20:34

*"But you shall remember the Lord your God, for it is He who is giving you power to make wealth, that He may confirm His covenant which He swore to your fathers, as it is this day.* - Deuteronomy 8:18

*The Lord will command the blessing upon you in your barns and in all that you put your hand to,* - Deuteronomy 28:8
