"Adoption" in the NT refers to the official act of a father who bestows the status of full adulthood on a son of minor status. It is not the taking in of an outsider; it is the placing of a family member into the privileges and blessings of adulthood. This means that even the youngest Christian has everything that Christ has and is rich in grace. (Wiersbe's) Adoption is the act of God by which He gives His "born ones" an adult standing in the family.
