Paul's unique calling and purpose: 1stto preach to the Gentiles the unfathomable riches of Christ (v.8)
Unsearchable (NIV), unfathomable (NASU) Anexichnaiaston: that cannot be traced out, that cannot be comprehended (Thayer's) Preach: euangelizoo - to bring good news, to announce glad tidings (Thayer's) (v.8)
To reveal what was God's for all ages 2 nd and to bring to light (photizo) what is the administration (oikonomia) of the mystery which for ages has been hidden in God who created all things; - Ephesians 3:9 (NASU)
"So That" God's ultimate purpose (v.10): Reveal God's "infinite" wisdom Manifold: polupoikilos - much-variegated; marked with a great variety of colors: of cloth or a painting, manifesting itself in a great variety of forms (Thayer's), mani-sided (CJB), infinite (GWT)
Angels learn of the manifold wisdom of God by (v.10) Even angels long to look into these things 1 Peter 1:12 (NIV)
We have been made a spectacle to the whole universe, to angels as well as to men - 1 Corinthians 4:9 (NIV)
In Him we have redemption through His blood, the forgiveness of outrespasses, according to the riches of His grace which He lavished on us Ephesians 1:7-8 (NASU)
