Machaira: _____
Sword: *machaira* - "a short sword or dagger (Vine's)

Romphaia: a _____
Sword: *romphaia* - a sabre, i.e., a long and broad cutlass
(any weapon of the kind) (OTESD)

...out of his (Jesus) mouth went a sharp two-edged
sword (*romphaia*) - Revelation 1:16 (CWSB)

Rhema: a _____
Man shall not live on bread alone, but on every word (*rhema*)
that proceeds out of the mouth of God. - Matthew 4:4 (NASB95)

Word: *rhéma*, to speak.
That which is spoken, a statement, word. (CWSB)

Logos: The _____
Word: *lógos* - to speak intelligently. discourse, saying, thing,
the Word of God, i.e., the divine doctrines and precepts of the
gospel, the gospel itself (CWSB)

For the word (*logos*) of God is living, and active, and sharper than
any two-edged sword (*machaira*), and piercing even to the dividing
of soul and spirit, of both joints and marrow, and quick to discern
the thoughts and intents of the heart. - Hebrews 4:12 (ASV)
