Enosh- **(vs. 9-11)**

enowsh (en-oshe'); from OT:605; properly, a mortal

Kenan- **(vs.12-14)**

Qeynan (kay-nawn'); from the same as OT:7064;qen;fixed

Misler's Commentary from (Numbers 24:21-23)

quwn (koon); a primitive root;. chant or wail (at a funeral):KJV - lament, mourning woman.

Mahalalel- **(vs.15-17)**

Mahalal'el (mah-hal-al-ale'); from OT:4110 and OT:410; praise of God

Jared- **(vs.18-20)**

Yered (yeh'-red); from OT:3381yarad (yaw-rad'); a primitive root; to descend (literally, to go downwards, come down

Enoch- **(21-24)**

Chanowk (khan-oke'); from OT:2596; chanak ; a primitive root; to initiate or discipline: KJV - dedicate, train up.

First Prophet Now Enoch, the seventh from Adam, prophesied about these men also, saying, "Behold, the Lord comes with ten thousands of His saints, 15 to execute judgment on all, to convict all who are ungodly among them of all their ungodly deeds which they have committed in an ungodly way, and of all the harsh things which ungodly sinners have spoken against Him." Jude 14-1514
