Kenan: _____ (vv.12-14)
Qeynan: fixed (Strong's)
Quwn: a primitive root; chant or wail (at a funeral) (KJV)
Lament, mourning (BDB) (Missler)

Mahalalel: _____ (vv.15-17)
Mahalal'el: (mah-hal-al-ale'); praise of God (Strong's)

Jared: _____ (vv.18-20)
Yered: to descend (literally, to go downwards, come down (Strong's)

Enoch: _____ (vv.21-24)
Enoch: Chanowk - teacher (S&C) discipline, train up (Strong's)

Now Enoch, the seventh from Adam, prophesied about these men also, saying, "Behold, the Lord comes with ten thousands of His saints, to execute judgment on all, to convict all who are ungodly among them of all their ungodly deeds which they have committed in an ungodly way, and of all the harsh things which ungodly sinners have spoken against Him." - Jude 14-15 (NKJV)

Lamech: poor; made low (Hitchcock's)

Noah: _____ (v.32)
Noah: rest; comfort; (root = rest; comfort) (Smith & Cornwall 1986)
his name **Noah (Noach)** saying, *This same shall comfort (Nacham)*
- Genesis 5:29 (KJV)

Man (is) appointed mortal fixed/sorrow; (but) the Praise of God shall come down, teaching (that) His death shall bring the despairing rest (or comfort)
