Nimrod: rebellion (BD&B) (Hitchcock's) (Smith's)
Before: paniyim - against (Strong's)
Began: chahal - to profane, to defile, to pollute, to desecrate, to begin ritually b) sexually (BD&B)
To be: hayah - to be, to become, to come to pass, to exist, to happen, to fall out (BD&B)
Mighty one: gibbowr - warrior, tyrant, giant (Strong's)
...he runneth upon me like a giant (gibbowr) - Job 16:14 (KJV)
