*Stay here with the donkey," Abraham told the young men (na'ar)*

**Together:** yakh-ad - from OT:3161; properly, a unit, i.e. (adverb) unitedly, -alike, (al-) together

OT:3161 yaw-khad - a primitive root; to be (or become) one

(v.8) *And Abraham said, My son, God will provide himself a lamb for a burnt offering: so they went both of them together.*

- Genesis 22:8 (KJV)

(v.9) **Isaac, like Jesus, is \_\_\_\_\_**

*And being found in appearance as a man, He humbled Himself and became obedient to the point of death, even the death of the cross.*

- Philippians 2:8 (NKJV)

(v.13) **A ram to show the fulfillment was not \_\_\_\_\_**

*The next day John saw Jesus coming toward him, and said, "Behold! The Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world!"*
