**Hated:** saw-nay - a primitive root; to hate (personally):

KJV - enemy, foe, (be) hate (-ful)

odious, utterly (Strong's)

(v.32)

**Reuben:** Behold a son! (Easton's)

*...surely now my husband will love me.*

- Genesis 29:32 (NASU)

(v.33)

**Simeon:** hearing (Easton's)

**Unloved:** hated; saw-nay; to hate (personally) (Strong's)

(v.34)

**Levi:** adhesion (Easton's), joined (NBD)

(v. 35)

**Judah:** the praise of the Lord (Easton's)
