(vv.5-6) **Dan:** judgment; he that judges (Hitchcock's)

(vv.7-8) **Naphtali:** my wrestling (Strong's)
Rachel named him Naphtali, for she said, "I have had an intense struggle with my sister, and I am winning!" - Genesis 30:8 (NLT)

(v.9) **Zilpah:** drooping (Easton's)

(vv.10-11) **Gad:** lord of fortune, or troop of Baal (Easton's)
Then Leah said, "How fortunate!" So she named him Gad. (NASU)
And Leah said, A troop cometh: and she called his name Gad. (KJV)

(vv.12-13) **Asher:** happy (Easton's)

(vv.17-18) **Issachar:** Yissakar

Sakar: payment of contract; concretely, salary, fare, maintenance; by implication, compensation, benefit

(vv.19-20) **Zebulun:** dwelling; habitation (Hitchcock's)

(Leah) Surely my husband will love me now." - Genesis 29:32 (NIV)

(Leah) gave birth to a son she said, "Now at last my husband will become attached to me, because I have borne him three sons
- Genesis 29:34 (NIV)

(v.21) **Dinah:** judged (Easton's)

(Jacob) took with him to Egypt his sons and grandsons and his daughters and granddaughters - Genesis 46:7 (NIV)
(and Genesis 37:34-35)

(vv.22-24) **Joseph:** Yowceph - let him add (Strong's)
