Joshua in the Hebrew is in Greek
Jesus: iesous - is a transliteration of the Hebrew "Joshua," meaning
"Jehovah is salvation" (VCED)
(vv.1-2)
Jericho is about
Jericho: yerichah Moon: yareach (OTESD)
Jericho: moon city (MCED)
The walls of Jericho were high and thick But the people who live there are strong, and their cities are large
(fortified [ESV]) and walled Numbers 13:28 (CEV)
(Tortified [LSV]) and walled Numbers 13.20 (GLV)

Like Joshua, God brings all of us to the point where all we have to go

The Plan: (vv.3-5)
Notice: The battle plan is not too kosher
1. Priests were exempt from war (Numbers 1:47-53)
2. Ark wasn't to be taken into war (1 Samuel 4&5)

3. Trumpet for war was to be made of silver (Numbers 10:2&9)
4. On the Sabbath they travel 7 times farther

3 Lessons While Marching:
1. We understand the of the situation 'Not by might nor by power, but by My Spirit,' says the LORD of hosts.
- Zechariah 4:6 (NASB95)
- Zechahan 4.0 (NASB93)
2. We develop
so that you will not be sluggish, but imitators of those who through faith
and patience inherit the promises Hebrews 6:12 (NASB95)
3. We learn (v.10)
avoid worldly and empty chatter, for it will lead to further ungodliness, and
their talk will spread like gangrene 2 Timothy 2:16-17 (NASB)

(vv.16-17)
all who are with her in the house, for she hid the messengers (mal-awk) whom we sent Joshua 6:17 (YLT)
Messengers: <i>mal-awk'</i> - a messenger; specifically, of God, i.e. an angel (also a prophet, priest or teacher) (OTESD)
"Shout! (rua) For the LORD has given you the city." - Joshua 6:16 (NASB)
O come, let us sing unto the LORD: let us make a joyful noise (rua) to the rock of our salvation. Let us come before his presence with thanksgiving, and make a joyful noise (rua) unto him with psalms Psalms 95:1-2 (KJV)
Now the part that most miss:
(God) I will give you every place where you set your foot, as I promised Moses Joshua 1:3 (NIV)
houses filled with all kinds of good things you did not provide, wells you did not dig, and vineyards and olive groves you did not plant Deuteronomy 6:11 (NIV)
And as for you, you are to be careful of the devoted things, lest you defile yourselves by taking some of the devoted things, and make the camp of Israel a curse, and trouble it Joshua 6:18 (LBT)
