The Result (v.17)

Possibly: Everyone shows up at _____ (v.17)

When Jesus came back to Capernaum a few days later, it was heard that He was at home. And many were gathered together, so that there was no longer space, not even near the door; and He was speaking the word to them. - Mark 2:1-2 (NASB)

(v.18)

Some men came carrying a paralytic (paralyzo) on a mat and tried to take him into the house to lay him before Jesus. (NIV)

...bringing to him a paralyzed man, carried by four of them.

- Mark 2:3 (NIV)

Jesus used “Anthropos” so it would apply to _____ (v.20)

When He saw their faith, He said to him, “Man (anthropos), your sins are forgiven you.” - Luke 5:20 (NKJV)

Man: *anthropos* - a human being, whether male or female generically, to include all human individuals (OTESD)
