Weeping: <i>klaioō</i> - To weep, wail, implying not only the shedding of tears, but also every external expression of grief, (CWSBD)			

Weeping: *klaioō* - To weep, wail, implying not only the shedding of tears, but also every external expression of grief. (CWSBD) To sob, i.e. wail aloud (whereas 1145 is rather to cry silently): bewail (OTESD)

Wet: *brechō* - a primary verb; to moisten (especially by a shower) (send) rain, wash, to cause to rain, to pour the rain, to send down like rain (OTESD)
