Ten Lepers Cleansed (vv.11-19)

Acted in faith with no _____ **but His** _____

The cleansing wasn't _____ *...as they were going... (v.14)*

This shall be the law of the leper in the day of his cleansing: He shall be brought unto the priest: And the priest shall go forth out of the camp; and the priest shall look, and, behold, if the plague of leprosy be healed in the leper... And the priest shall command -- that one of the birds be killed in an earthen vessel over running water. - Leviticus 14:2-5 (CWSB)

Now one of them, when he saw that he had been healed, turned back, glorifying (doxazo) God with a loud voice, and he fell on his face at His feet, giving thanks (eucharisteo) to Him. And he was a Samaritan.
