"When you enter your neighbor's standing grain, then you may pluck the heads with your hand, but you shall not wield a sickle in your neighbor's standing grain. Deuteronomy 23:25

Born "Simon" (Jewish name) but Jesus called him Peter: Petros-- a piece of a rock. (Greek) In English we would call him "Rocky".

James and John Jesus called them "The Sons of Thunder".

Andrew (Andreas) means "Manly" from Aner-man.

Philip (φιλι' ihp) Personal name meaning, "fond of horses".

A Greek name given by his parents.

Bartholomew means "son of a Plowman". (Jewish name)

He was born Levi but Jesus called him Matthew. As a Tax Collector he was hated by everyone and trusted by no one. Jesus called him "Matthew" which means "Gift of God".

Thomas (Thohm' uhs) Personal name from Hebrew meaning, "a twin." Didymus: Greek for twin.

James is called "James the less" in Mark 15:40.

Less-mikros: small, little, least, less, little, short, small.

Simon the Zealot Member of a fanatical, Jewish, nationalistic, political sect: revolutionary (Strong's) [zealots] resorted to violence and assassination in their hatred of the foreigner. (ISBE)
