

## DEVELOPING DISCIPLES

Mark 6: 1-34

### (v.1) Jesus' 2<sup>nd</sup> visit home

And He came to Nazareth, where He had been brought up; and as was His custom, He entered the synagogue on the Sabbath, and stood up to read. Luke 4:16

...and they got up and drove Him out of the city, and led Him to the brow of the hill on which their city had been built, in order to throw Him down the cliff. Luke 4:29

### (v.3) ...and they were being stumbled at him. Mark 6:3 (YLT)

Offense-skandalizoō; to be caused to stumble, to be repelled

For not even His brothers were believing in Him. John 7:5-6 (3:21)

### (v.5) God is limited by my \_\_\_\_\_

"According to your faith will it be done to you"; Matthew 9:29 (NIV)

And He marveled (*thaumazo*) because of their unbelief. Mark 6:6

Now when Jesus heard this, He marveled (*thaumazo*) and said to those who were following, "Truly I say to you, I have not found such great faith with anyone in Israel. Matthew 8:10

### (v.6) The antidote for unbelief is \_\_\_\_\_

He had compassion on them, because they were like sheep without a shepherd. So He began teaching them many things. Mark 6:34

His divine power has granted to us everything pertaining to life and godliness, through the true knowledge of Him who called us by His own glory and excellence. 4 For by these He has granted to us His precious and magnificent promises, so that by them you may become partakers of the divine nature, 2 Peter 1:3-4

### Next Step: Survival Faith (w.7-13)

Even in your law it has been written that the testimony of two men is true. John 8:17

Two people are better than one because together they have a good reward for their hard work. 10 If one falls, the other can help his friend get up. Ecclesiastes 4:9-10
