*And they ate and were satisfied (**chortazo**); and they picked up seven large baskets (**spuris**) full of what was left over of the broken pieces. Mark 8:8*

Satisfied—chortazo- to gorge (supply food in abundance)

Large Baskets-spuris- a (large, flexible) basket (for carrying provisions)

Last Time: *...they picked up twelve full baskets (**kophinos**) of the broken pieces, and also of the fish. Mark 6:43*

Kophino- a (small) basket

...twelve [small hand] baskets of broken pieces. Luke 9:17 (AMP)
