

**5. Conclusion: Everybody's Sinfulness**  
**The truth about me apart from Him (vv.9-19)**

**Point 1: Man's \_\_\_\_\_ (vv.10-12)**

*"Suppose one of you has a hundred sheep and loses one of them. Does he not leave the ninety-nine in the open country and go after the lost sheep until he finds it? Luke 15:4*

*"No one can come to Me, unless the Father who sent Me draws him; and I will raise him up on the last day. John 6:44*

*And Isaiah is very bold and says, "I WAS FOUND BY THOSE WHO SOUGHT ME NOT, I BECAME MANIFEST TO THOSE WHO DID NOT ASK FOR ME." Romans 10:20*

*The Lord is not slow about His promise, as some count slowness, but is patient toward you, not wishing for any to perish but for all to come to repentance. 2 Peter 3:9*

**Point 2: Man's \_\_\_\_\_ (vv.13-17)**

*For the mouth speaks out of that which fills the heart. Matthew 12:34*

*And since we have the same spirit of faith, according to what is written, "I believed and therefore I spoke," we also believe and therefore speak, 2 Corinthians 4:13*

*Look also at ships: although they are so large and are driven by fierce winds, they are turned by a very small rudder wherever the pilot desires. 5 Even so the tongue is a little member and boasts great things. James 3:4-5*

**Point 3: The \_\_\_\_\_ (v.18)**

*There is no fear of God before their eyes." Romans 3:18*

**GOD'S PERSPECTIVE**  
**Romans 3:1-20**

**1. Israel's \_\_\_\_\_ (vv.1-2)**

*They shall construct an ark of acacia wood... "You shall overlay it with pure gold, inside and out you shall overlay it **You shall put into the ark the testimony which I shall give you.** Exodus 25:10-16*

**2. God's \_\_\_\_\_ (vv.3-4)**

*I will make you a great nation; I will bless you And make your name great; And you shall be a blessing. 3 I will bless those who bless you, And I will curse him who curses you; And in you all the families of the earth shall be blessed." Genesis 12:2-3*

*Then it will happen on that day that the Lord Will again recover the second time with His hand The remnant of His people, who will remain, From Assyria, Egypt, Pathros, Cush, Elam, Shinar, Hamath, And from the islands of the sea. 12 And He will lift up a standard for the nations, And will assemble the banished ones of Israel, And will gather the dispersed of Judah From the four corners of the earth. Isaiah 11:11-12*

**3. God's \_\_\_\_\_ (vv.5-6)**

**Doesn't my "Bad" bring about His "Good"?**

*"But," some say, "our breaking faith with God is good, our sins serve a good purpose, for people will notice how good God is when they see how bad we are. Is it fair, then, for him to punish us when our sins are helping him?" (That is the way some people talk.) 6 God forbid! Then what kind of God would he be, to overlook sin? How could he ever condemn anyone? Romans 3:5-6 (TLB)*

**4. God's \_\_\_\_\_ (vv.7-9)**

*...but they are wrong and deserve the punishment they will receive Romans 3:8 (NCV)*  
*Do not be deceived, God is not mocked; for whatever a man sows, this he will also reap Galatians 6:7*
