Paul always brought the Gospel of

Euaggelizo: to announce good news, especially the gospel

Paul's Audience:

Some of the Jews were persuaded and joined Paul and Silas, as did a large number of God-fearing Greeks and not a few prominent women. - Acts 17:4

... you turned to God from idols to serve the living and true God,

- 1 Thessalonians 1:9 (NIV)

The Gospel of Mega Joy came with

...for our gospel (euaggelion) did not come to you in word only, but also in power (dunamis) and in the Holy Spirit and with full conviction; - 1 Thessalonians 1:5 (NASB)

Dunamis: force - specially, miraculous power (usually by implication, a miracle itself) (Strong's)

He could not do any miracles (dunamis) there, except lay his hands on a few sick people and heal them. And he was amazed at their lack of faith. - Mark 6:5-6 (NIV)
