**David's Consequences:**

**David's first son by Bathsheba dies**

2 Samuel 12:15-18A

**David's son, Amnon, rapes his own sister, Tamar.**

2 Samuel 13:1-19

**Absalom, one of David's other sons, plans and executes the murder of Amnon as revenge for his sister Tamar**

**David's son, Absalom, flees**

2 Samuel 13:30-39

**When Joab, David's general, refuses to arrange an audience with David for Absalom, Absalom commits arson by burning Joab's barley field**

2 Samuel 14:28-33

**Absalom commits insurrection working a conspiracy to win over the hearts of the men of Israel and steal his father's throne**

2 Samuel 15:1-13

**David needs to flee for his life from his own home**

2 Samuel 15:14

**David is publically cursed, heckled, and attacked**

2 Samuel 16:5-13

**To show the nation of Israel that he is completely separated from his father, David, Absalom puts on a public display of immorality in front of all the people**

2 Samuel 16:20-22

**David has to go to war against his own son, Absalom.**

2 Samuel 18:1-8

**David's son, Absalom, is killed by David's own army**

2 Samuel 18:9-15

*"If your hand or foot causes you to sin, cut it off and cast it from you. It is better for you to enter into life lame or maimed, rather than having two hands or two feet, to be cast into the everlasting fire. And if your eye causes you to sin, pluck it out and cast it from you. It is better for you to enter into life with one eye, rather than having two eyes, to be cast into hell fire.*
