

WORDS AND FAITH Hebrews 11

See that you are not frightened, for those things must take place, but that is not yet the end. – Matthew 24:6 (NASU)

(Jesus) However, when the Son of Man comes, will He find faith on the earth?" - Luke 18:8 (NASB)

Jesus said to them, "Because of your unbelief; for assuredly, I say to you, if you have faith as a mustard seed, you will say to this mountain, 'Move from here to there,' and it will move; and nothing will be impossible for you. - Matthew 17:20 (NKJV)

By faith [with confidence in God and His word] Noah, being warned by God about events not yet seen, in reverence prepared an ark for the salvation of his family... - Hebrews 11:7 (Amplified)

...faith comes by hearing, and hearing by the word (rhema) of God (Christos) - Romans 10:17 (NKJV) (Christos)

Example: The Lord is increasing me more and more, me and my children, for I am blessed of the Lord the Maker of Heaven and Earth - Psalms 115:14-15

This book of the law shall not depart from your mouth, but you shall meditate (**hagah- talk, speak, mutter**) on it day and night, so that you may be careful to do according to all that is written in it; for then you will make your way prosperous, and then you will have success - Joshua 1:8 (NASB)

Example: The Lord has commanded the blessing upon me in my barns and in all that I put my hand to, and He is blessing me in the land which the Lord my God gives me. - Deuteronomy 28:8 (NASB) (Deuteronomy 28:1-14)

Now what I am commanding you today is not too difficult for you or beyond your reach. It is not up in heaven, so that you have to ask, "Who will ascend into heaven to get it and proclaim it to us so we may obey it?" Nor is it beyond the sea, so that you have to ask, "Who will cross the sea to get it and proclaim it to us so we may obey it?" No, the word is very near you; it is in your mouth and in your heart so you may obey it. See, I set before you today life and prosperity, death and destruction. - Deuteronomy 30:11-15 (NIV)

"Do not say in your heart, 'Who will ascend into heaven?'" (that is, to bring Christ down)" or 'Who will descend into the deep?'" (that is, to bring Christ up from the dead). But what does it say? "The word is near you; it is in your mouth and in your heart," that is, the word of faith we are proclaiming: - Romans 10:6-9

The key to Faith is _____ saying what God _____
(Jesus) the One who sent me is true; **so I say in the world only what I have heard from him.** - John 8:26 (CJB)

Let us hold fast the profession (homologian) of our faith without wavering; (for he is faithful that promised;) - Hebrews 10:23 (KJV)
