Faith begins as a _____

And the Lord said, "If you had faith like a mustard seed, you would say to this mulberry tree, 'Be uprooted and be planted in the sea'; and it would obey you. - Luke 17:6 (NASU)

A seed only becomes effective when it's _____

You would say to... - Luke 17:6

And Jesus said to him, "If you can! All things are possible for one who believes." Immediately the father of the child cried out and said, "I believe; help my unbelief!" - Mark 9:23-25 (ESV)

...faith comes by hearing, and hearing by the word (rhema) of God (Christos) - Romans 10:17 (NKJV)

This book of the law shall not depart from your mouth, but you shall meditate (hagah- talk, speak, mutter) on it day and night, so that you may be careful to do according to all that is written in it; for then you will make your way prosperous, and then you will have success - Joshua 1:8 (NASB)

Then Joshua spoke to the Lord in the day when the Lord delivered up the Amorites before the children of Israel, and he said in the sight of Israel: "Sun, stand still over Gibeon; And Moon, in the Valley of Aijalon." - Joshua 10:12 (NKJV)

Isaiah 55

(vv.6-8)

But we have the mind of Christ. - 1 Corinthians 2:16 (NASB)

I planted, Apollos watered, but God was causing the growth. - 1 Corinthians 3:6-7 (NASB)

A good man out of the good treasure of his heart brings forth good things, and an evil man out of the evil treasure brings forth evil things. But I say to you that for every idle (argos) word men may speak, they will give account of it in the day of judgment. For by your words you will be justified, and by your words you will be condemned." - Matthew 12:35-37 (NKJV)

Idle: argos - inactive, i.e. unemployed; (by implication) lazy, useless

Therefore, putting aside all filthiness and all that remains of wickedness, in humility receive the word implanted, which is able to save your souls (psuche) - James 1:21 (NASB)

If anyone thinks himself to be religious, and yet does not bridle his tongue but deceives his own heart, this man's religion is worthless (mataios) - James 1:26

Worthless: mataios - empty, i.e. (literally) profitless (Strong's)
