

FAITH THOUGHTS

Romans 10

Jesus said to them, "Because of your unbelief; for assuredly, I say to you, if you have faith as a mustard seed, you will say to this mountain, 'Move from here to there,' and it will move; and nothing will be impossible for you. - Matthew 17:20 (NKJV) (Luke 17:6)

...faith comes by hearing, and hearing by the word (rhema) of God (Christos) - Romans 10:17 (NKJV)

...that if you confess (homologeō) with your mouth Jesus as Lord, and believe in your heart that God raised Him from the dead, you will be saved (sozo); for with the heart a person believes, resulting in righteousness, and with the mouth he confesses (homologeō), resulting in salvation (soteria). For the Scripture says, "WHOEVER BELIEVES IN HIM WILL NOT BE DISAPPOINTED." - Rom 10:9-11

Confession: (homologeō, homologia) to speak the same thing (Vine's)

Salvation: soteria - rescue or safety (KJV)
deliver, health, salvation, save, saving (Strong's)

Saved: sozo - "safe"; to save, i.e. deliver or protect (KJV)
heal, preserve, save, do well, be (make) whole (Strong's)

...for she was saying to herself, "If I only touch His garment, I will get well (sozo)." But Jesus turning and seeing her said, "Daughter, take courage; your faith has made you well (sozo)." At once the woman was made well (sozo). - Matthew 9:21-22

Those who had seen it reported to them how the man who was demon-possessed had been made well (sozo). - Luke 8:36

And the prayer of faith shall save (sozo) the sick, - James 5:15

And His disciples came to Him, and awoke Him, saying, Lord, save (sozo) us: we perish. - Matthew 8:25
