...but you will receive power (*dunamis*) when the Holy Spirit has come upon you; and you shall be My witnesses (*martus*) both in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and even to the remotest part of the earth."

- Acts 1:8 (NASB95)

The purpose of the power is to be _____ (*martus*) (v.8)
