

## ORDER IN THE CHURCH II

1 Corinthians 14:20-40

July 29/30, 2023

"God has given each of us the ability to do certain things well. . . "

- Romans 12:6 (LB)

Therefore you do not lack any spiritual gift as you eagerly wait for our Lord Jesus Christ to be revealed. - 1 Corinthians 1:7 (NIV)

...if the whole church gathers (v.23) (NASB)

**Tongues: Speaking to \_\_\_\_\_** (v.2)

But the one who prophesies speaks to people for their strengthening, encouraging and comfort. - 1 Corinthians 14:3 (NIV)

**Tongues in church** (vv.18-19)

...do not forbid speaking in tongues - 1 Corinthians 14:39 (NIV)

**Goal of Church Meeting: \_\_\_\_\_** (vv.18-19)

**Tongues: A Sign to Unbelievers?** (vv.21-22)

For with stammering lips and another tongue will he speak to this people...Yet they would not hear - Isaiah 28:11-12 (KJV) (760 BC)

**The result for some then and now: \_\_\_\_\_** (v.21)

And they all continued in amazement and great perplexity, saying to one another, "What does this mean?" But others were mocking and saying, "They are full of sweet wine." - Acts 2:12-13 (NASB95)

**Be Sensitive to Outsiders** (v.23)

**Calvary's Motto for Church Services:** \_\_\_\_\_

If therefore the whole church be come together into one place, and all speak with tongues, and there come in those that are unlearned (idiotes), or unbelievers, will they not say that ye are mad?

- 1 Corinthians 14:23 (CWSB)

**Prophecy benefits \_\_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_\_\_** (vv.24-25)

But everyone who prophesies speaks to men for their strengthening, encouragement and comfort. - 1 Corinthians 14:3 (NIV)
