In The Last Days _____ **becomes a** _____ **again**
(GOD) you will come up against **My people Israel** like a cloud to cover the land. It will come about in the **last days** that I shall bring you against **My land** - Ezekiel 38:16 (NASB77)

As it was in the days of Noah, so it will be at the coming of the Son of Man. - Matthew 24:37 (NIV)

...and the earth was filled with violence (Hamas) - Gen 6:11 (NASB)

Violence: חָמָס *hâmas* - a primitive root; to be violent (OTESD)

You must understand this: In the last days there will be violent (chalepos) periods of time. - 2 Timothy 3:1-2 (GWT)

Violent: *chalepos* - violent, fierce, difficult, grievous (CWSB)

Know this first of all, that in the last days mockers will come with their mocking, following after their own lusts, and saying, "Where is the promise of His coming? For ever since the fathers fell asleep, all continues just as it was from the beginning of creation." For when they maintain this, it escapes their notice that by the word of God the heavens existed long ago and the earth was formed out of water and by water - 2 Peter 3:3-5 (NASB95), (John 3:1-3)

Therefore, ridding yourselves of all filthiness and all that remains of wickedness, in humility receive the word implanted (emphuton), which is able (*dunamai*) to save (*sozo*) your souls (psyche).

- James 1:21 (NASB)

...welcome with meekness the implanted word that has the power (*dunamai*) to save your souls (psyche). - James 1:21 (NRSV)

Save: *sozo* - deliver or protect, heal, preserve, save (self), do well, be (make) whole. (OTESD)

She said to herself, "If I only touch his cloak, I will be healed (*sozo*)."
Jesus turned and saw her. "Take heart, daughter," he said, "your faith has healed (*sozo*) you." And the woman was healed (*sozo*) at that moment. - Matthew 9:21-22 (NIV)
